Board Votes:

The Minutes from October 10, 2025 were approved unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report from October 2025 was approved unanimously. We currently have 708 members and a projected surplus of \$6,000.

The 2026 Budget was approved by the membership.

The By-Law changes were approved by the membership.

Election Planning:

In March of 2026, three Board positions will become vacant: President, Treasurer, and one Director at Large. Members were encouraged to consider running for these positions. The Club will also need at least one volunteer for the Election Committee.

Don't Fall Festival and Court Initiatives:

The success of the Fall Festival was discussed and plans were announced for the third annual Christmas on the Courts (the morning of Dec 25). 70+ play was introduced and the need for participants to sign up through Court Reserve to help allocate the required number of courts. An In-House Tournament is planned for March with a round robin format. Members were encouraged to submit ideas for additional alternative play.

HOA Proposals:

The Club submitted three HOA projects: dinking wall, water and ice pavilion, and lighting for the eight non-lit courts. Unfortunately, none were approved in the HOA budget. However, the HOA forwarded all three projects to the developer for funding consideration.

Court Reserve:

About half of our membership has logged into Court Reserve. The system is being used to register for events like Skills and Drills, Pickleball Machine Training, and Saturday alternative play. Videos of pickleball instructions will be added to the website soon.

Court Maintenance:

The torn windsock was replaced. The ripped net on court 14 was replaced. An electrical outlet for fans was added to court 12.

Membership Renewal:

Membership fees will remain at \$30 for the year. A renewal email will be sent December 31, 2025. Members may renew and pay on-line through Court Reserve. They also have the option of paying by cash or check by filling out the paper form and submitting it and payment into the locked box by Court 1.

Pickleball Noise:

Noise concerns were discussed. It was explained that court hours are governed by the HOA's CC&R, which allows play from sunrise to 10pm. The Club does not have authority over the courts and cannot enforce noise regulations. Members were encouraged to contact the HOA if noise becomes an issue. Members also complained about noise from leaf blowers used near the courts. The Board suggested members communicate their concerns to Mike Taylor about potentially switching to electric blowers.
