

General Meeting Minutes

February 13, 2026

Board Approvals:

Minutes for January 9 General Meeting were unanimously approved.

Treasurer's Report for January was unanimously approved.

The Club currently has 618 members. We have \$43,287 in the bank. We are now exclusively using Court Reserve to send emails. This allowed us to cancel our Constant Contact subscription for a saving of \$400.

Membership Renewals:

74% of the members renewed on-line. We've had 26 new members join the Club this month. 133 did not renew. That number is almost identical from last year. One third of those moved. The majority of the rest are 2.5 or 3.0. The Board can make some assumptions about why they didn't renew (tried it and didn't like it, injuries, etc), but we will do a deeper dive to try to decrease that number in the future. It's not too late to renew if you haven't already. Additionally, there is an auto-renew feature on Court Reserve. You have to set up a payment profile to use it.

Club Committees:

The Board would like to create some committees to take some of the workload off the Board. Lynn is working on a framework. We will be asking for volunteers soon.

Court Crowding:

Lynn has been collecting data on court usage. 3.0 has the highest demand, especially on Wednesdays and Fridays. Mike Taylor agreed to give us 2 HOA courts for the 3.0 round robin for the remainder of the season. We updated the schedule to reflect the change and we will post the Approved Club usage on the HOA courts. The Board is trying to schedule a meeting with the HOA, including Jack Scarsam, to update them on our goals and needs.

Testing Update:

Brian Miller, the Testing Coordinator, gave an update. There have been 92 requests-7 withdrew, 39 passed, 23 did not pass, and 23 are still waiting to test. The testing season will end on April 1.

In-House Tournament:

So far we have 81 paid registrants. We are still encouraging people to play. An email went out asking for volunteers. There will be a Tournament 101 Class on March 13 at 4:00 at the Courts to help anyone unfamiliar with tournament play.

End of Season Party:

Party will be March 21. The Grill is catering, Jerry will DJ, and there will be raffle prizes. Members can purchase food tickets on Court Reserve. **If you are playing in the In-House Tournament, your food voucher is included in the entry fee.**

Election Process:

Voting will begin on March 9. There will be three ways to vote: Survey Monkey, email, and in-person. An email will be sent with all the details. We will have a five minute General Meeting at the beginning of the party to announce the new Board.

Member Questions:

A member asked if we could do a petition to cut down the trees on Robson Blvd because they make a mess on the courts and create shadows. The Board does not believe Robson would agree to that and we need to pick our battles wisely.
